

The Russian Toy is a generally healthy breed. In order for the Russian Toy Club of America to promote responsible breeding practices, we recommend that our breeding dogs have passing screening tests performed for the following potentially inherited conditions: Patellar Luxation, inherited eye disease and Cardio.

Required Tests:

- Patellar Luxation OFA Evaluation
- Eye Examination OFA Registered Ophthalmologist
- Basic Cardio OFA Evaluation

Recommended Tests:

- OFA Legs-Calve-Perthes Radiographic Evaluation
- OFA Hips for Hip Dysplasia
- OFA Elbows for Elbow Dysplasia
- OFA Bile Acid for Liver Shunts

If members are not aware, the Russian Toy is in the OFA CHIC Database and the above required tests for the dogs to achieve a CHIC number.
